Risk or Hazard	Control Measures
Injury due to Fire	<ul> <li>An electronic fire alarm and sensors are in situ</li> <li>All Fire Exits and routes are kept clear of obstruction and are clearly signed</li> <li>All fire exits are kept unlocked through liaison with all tenants</li> <li>All fire safety and fire fighting equipment is checked regularly, maintained annually and is in good working condition</li> <li>Key staff hold current Fire Warden Certificate</li> <li>Flammables and ignition sources are stored separately</li> <li>All staff are trained on the evacuation procedure as part of the staff induction procedure</li> </ul>
Injury due to Electrical Contact	<ul> <li>All electrics are installed by a NICEIC technician</li> <li>All Portable appliances are inspected annually and are in good working condition</li> <li>No wiring is accessible to the public</li> </ul>

Slips, Trips and Falls	<ul> <li>All areas are kept clear of obstruction at all times</li> <li>All spillages are signed and cleaned immediately</li> <li>All Fixtures and fittings are checked daily as part of the Daily Operational procedure</li> <li>All gaming scenery is clearly marked and visible</li> <li>The Gaming Area is inspected daily and regularly</li> <li>Gamers are briefed on Safety Rules and conduct prior to each game session</li> <li>Safety Rules and Code of Conduct are displayed around the site</li> <li>Suitable Lighting and Emergency Lighting</li> </ul>
First Aid	<ul> <li>is provided in all areas</li> <li>Duty Managers are First Aid Qualified</li> <li>A fully stocked First Aid Kit is kept on site at all times</li> <li>All incidents are recorded and investigated appropriately, as part of the Recording and Monitoring procedure</li> </ul>
Appropriate conduct	<ul> <li>All staff are trained on the Company Code of Conduct Policy as part of the Staff Induction Procedure</li> <li>Any Individuals who exhibit inappropriate behaviour are not allowed on site</li> <li>Any individuals clearly under the influence of intoxicating substances are not permitted to partake in activities</li> <li>All areas of the Site are adequately supervised by Members of Staff and CCTV at all times as far as is reasonably practicable</li> <li>Games are supervised by a member of staff</li> <li>Schools/Groups &amp; Clubs must additionally assist with game supervision</li> <li>Parent/Guardians are accountable for overall behaviour of their children.</li> <li>Players under the age of 6 or 1.1m may not partake.</li> </ul>
COSHH	<ul> <li>All hazardous substances are stored in a locked area, only accessible by trained and competent staff</li> <li>All staff are trained on the appropriate use of substances as part of Induction</li> <li>All hazardous substances are appropriately labelled</li> </ul>
